Caveat:

* Of the 21 reported incidences, two were reported to Campus Security by the alleged victim while the other 19 were reported to Campus Security by a single third-party reporter to whom some of the reported incidences were themselves second-hand and unverified. Due to the manner of reporting of these 19 incidents and the period during which the incidences were alleged to have occurred (over a four year period), Campus Security was unable to verify (a) the accuracy of or the circumstances surrounding the alleged incidences; (b) whether any of the incidences were duplicate reports of previously reported and documented events; and (c) precisely how many alleged incidences occurred during any given reporting period. Nevertheless, because of the requirements of the Clery Act the College felt that the most transparent and forthright course of action was to report these alleged incidences along with this note of clarification.

Hate Crimes:

Reported Crimes: Involving crimes that must be reported in the annual report prepared by the Campus Security Authority and/or the local police agencies as required by the Clery Act.
