Students may apply for admission to Hanover College using this paper application, the online application (at www.hanover.edu), or the Common Application (paper or online version at www.commonapp.org).

Early Admission

Please note that all materials required for admission and scholarships must be **postmarked by December 1st** in order for candidates to be considered for Hanover College's non-binding Early Admission program. Students applying under the Early Admission program are automatically considered for all available merit-based scholarships.

Your application for admission will be complete and ready for review when the following items have been received:

- 1. Completed application**
- 2. Secondary School Report Form** (Submit the enclosed form to your guidance counselor and ask that he/she return that form to Hanover College with your official transcript, including your senior course schedule)
- 3. All SAT-I and/or ACT results** (Scores present on a high school transcript or from the SAT/ACT testing service are acceptable).
- 4. Essay**
- 5. \$40.00 application fee payable to Hanover College** (fee is waived if completing the online application)

This application is for Freshman applicants only.

If you are a transfer student or an International/Exchange student, you need to fill out the Transfer Student Application or the International/Exchange Student Application.

Financial Aid and Scholarship Programs

Applicants interested in being considered for federal, state or institutional need-based financial aid programs must **complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** after January 1st, but no later than March 10th of their senior year. **Hanover's school code for the FAFSA is 001801.**

Hanover also offers unique scholarship programs that reward outstanding students.

- **Global Scholars Program** – Because Hanover follows a 4-4-1 calendar (two four-month semesters followed by a month-long May Term), our students are given a unique opportunity to conduct research and study around the world for one month in the spring. Through the Global Scholars Program, students are **guaranteed funding for one off-campus May Term course during the student's sophomore, junior or senior year at Hanover in the U.S. or abroad.** Additional scholarships within this selective, invitation-only scholarship program **are awarded on a competitive basis and range up to full-tuition in value.** For more information about this program, go to www.hanover.edu/gsp. The deadline to apply is December 1st.
- **Benjamin Templeton Scholars Program** – This program rewards exceptional student leaders that have proven to be academically successful. Templeton Scholars **awards up to ten full-tuition scholarships** to students that have participated in or initiated programs that promote diversity and equality in education, tolerance and social justice for race, gender, religion, sexual preference or national origin. To apply to be a Templeton scholar, go to www.hanover.edu/templeton. The deadline to apply is December 1st.
- **Visual and Performing Arts Scholarships** – Scholarships in studio art, music (vocal and instrumental) and theatre (performance and technical) are available to majors and non-majors in each area of interest. Renewable scholarships range from \$500 to \$3,500 and are awarded based on an audition or portfolio review. Students may audition for more than one of these scholarships, but must select one area if they receive more than one scholarship.
