### Registration

Initial registration will be complete when your registration form and release agreement are signed and returned with the camp fee check made out to Hanover College Football Camp. Final registration will take place on the day of the camp from 2 PM to 3 PM in the Concourse of Alumni Stadium. ### Camp Fees

The fee is **\$30** for the camp and required with the return of the registration form and liability release prior to the day of the camp. All checks must be made payable to Hanover College Football Camp. Refunds are available for any cancellation up to forty-eight hours from the start of camp minus a **\$10** processing and shirt fee. In the event of inclement weather, we will endeavor to hold activities indoors as available facilities permit. However, no refunds or transfers will be granted if inclement weather requires us to cancel a camp day. ### Arrival & Departure

Camp will begin at 3 PM after registration is complete. Camp will officially end at 6 PM. Campers and their parents can park in the main parking lot or in soccer/softball parking lot located by the stadium. Parents are encouraged to stay and watch in the stands in the stadium.

### Walk-ups

Walk-Ups: Day of camp registration is welcome, but a **\$40** day of camp fee must be paid in cash and all forms must be signed by a parent or legal guardian before the camper may participate. Space in the camp is limited, so pre-registration is recommended.



### The Camp and Camp Objectives

Hanover College is offering campers the opportunity to interact with the Hanover coaching staff in an instructional college practice type setting. The Hanover College coaching staff will coach the camp with the teaching emphasis on the fundamentals and techniques of the game. The camp will feature individual and group instructional periods along with an assessment period. The camps feature a low athlete to coach ratio allowing for significant 1-on-1 attention. Questions? ### Head Coach Matt Theobald

Matt Theobald ('96) returns to his alma mater, as he was announced as the head coach of the Hanover College football program prior to the start of the 2016 season.

In his first season with HC, Theobald guided the Panthers to their most wins in three seasons, going 4-6. Hanover also recorded a 4-4 mark in the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference, giving the team its first conference winning percentage of .500 or better since 2013. The Blue and Red finished in a tie for fifth in the HCAC, improving two spots from the team's projected finish in the coaches' preseason poll.

Hanover also enjoyed its most all-conference selections since 2013, as 10 Panthers were honored. Quintin Stubbs-Lee picked up his first career all-HCAC first team selection under Theobald.

Prior to taking over at HC, Theobald spent 13 seasons at HCAC institution, Franklin. While he was with the Grizzlies, Theobald guided one of the nation's top-ranked offenses from 2013-2015. He also spent time as the team's defensive coordinator prior to his run with the offensive unit.

During his tenure at FC, he helped produce three HCAC Defensive and three HCAC Offensive Most Valuable Player awards.

A 1996 Hanover graduate, Theobald was a four-year letterman as a defensive back with the Panthers' football squad. He helped the program earn back-to-back Indiana Collegiate Athletic Conference titles in 1994 and 1995. He also started in the secondary for the team's 1995 NCAA Division III playoff debut.

After earning a political science degree, Theobald served on Hanover's coaching staff as a receivers coach, defensive backs coach and special teams coordinator from 1996-2000.

Theobald left the Panthers to help ignite a successful run at Waynesburg (Pa.) from 2000-2003. He served as the Yellow Jackets' special teams coordinator, defensive backs coach and recruiting coordinator.
